National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency

Next NGA West (N2W)

As a significant small business subcontractor to the McCarthy-HITT Joint Venture for their design-build-construction contract for the new NGA facility in St. Louis, Missouri, Akima integrates maintenance efficiencies into the design, develops a facilities maintenance plan as part of the build effort, supports construction operations, and establishes and populates the facility's Archibus computerized maintenance management system. Upon completion of construction, our team will provide facilities and infrastructure equipment operation and maintenance, industrial hygiene and environmental services, grounds maintenance, and management of real and property assets.

U.S. Air Force

Arnold Engineering Development Complex (AEDC) Facilities Support Services

Our team conducts the facility operations needed to enable test operations, industrial security, base operations, test facility and base infrastructure maintenance and improvement efforts, and many other services critical to operating and sustaining an active Air Force Base and the nation's largest collection of aerospace ground test facilities. The team performs work in 153 facilities ranging from an industrial security building and operations center, to six warehouses.

Facility Support Operations and Maintenance Services (FOMS)

Akima provides the full range of facility operations and maintenance support at the NASA Goddard Space Flight Center (GSFC). The GSFC site is approximately 1,428 acres, and consists of buildings, roadways, parking areas, open spaces, and underground utility infrastructure with utility plants. Akima provides 24/7 support and is often required to offer innovative approaches to meet challenging research and development requirements and schedules. Our responsibilities include preventive maintenance, repairs, trouble call response, reliability centered maintenance planning, central plant operations, and more.





U.S. Air Force - Air Mobility Command

MacDill Air Force Base Civil Engineering Services

Akima provides all personnel, equipment, tools, material, vehicles and fuel, supervision, and services to perform base civil engineer tasks and functions at MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa, FL. Our range of work includes preventive maintenance and repair for a massive infrastructure with more than 58 generators, 300 utility meters, 101 fire suppression systems, and 50.8 miles of paved roads. Our team executes an average of 6,650 preventive maintenance actions, recurring services, service calls, and minor construction items annually - completing most taskings in less than 50 hours.

DLA

Installation Support Services San Joaquin

Akima provides facility support services through efficient operations and maintenance at the DLA San Joaquin site in Tracy, CA, which consists of 71 buildings on 908 acres. Our team provides maintenance operations, preventive maintenance, and inspections of buildings, structures and installed equipment, and associated property. Skilled labor includes trades such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical, high voltage electrical, masonry, heating and air conditioning, and sheet metal working.

U.S. Navy - Naval Facilities Engineering Command Base Operating Support for Quantico Marine Corps Base

At U.S. Marine Corps Base Quantico in Quantico, VA, we have full responsibility for the management, supervision, labor, materials, equipment, incidental engineering, and transportation necessary to provide services for force protection, facility support services, facility management, facility investment, custodial, pest control, integrated solid waste management, grounds maintenance and landscaping, pavement clearance and environmental. The team uses MAXIMOTM, a computerized maintenance management system, to receive service calls, track work order history, asset management, and condition assessment.

Eastern Regional Research Center Operations and Maintenance Support Services

Our team supports the U.S. Department of Agriculture's continuing requirement for facility operations and maintenance support services for their Eastern Regional Research Center (ERRC) in Wyndmoor, Pennsylvania. As part of this program, we furnish all labor, equipment, supervision, materials, and incidentals for operations and maintenance services such as, but not limited, to heating, ventilation and air conditioning, security, janitorial, architectural and structural, grounds maintenance, pest control, housekeeping, electrical, piped systems, utilities, shipping/receiving, and administration of work management systems. We established a program to maintain the facility free of insects and vermin in accordance with the State of Pennsylvania and manufacturer's guidelines.

Western Regional Research Center Operations and Maintenance Support Services

We provide facility operations and maintenance support services at the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Western Regional Research Center (WRRC) located in Albany, California. Our building operations and maintenance support tasks at WRRC include, but are not limited to, work management, administrative services, facility maintenance, grounds maintenance, and utility services. Our team provides operational and maintenance support for the entire WRRC complex, including existing buildings, greenhouses and structures, renovated facilities, and new construction. Facilities operations and maintenance functions include the areas of work management, preventive maintenance, building maintenance, alteration and repair, installations, grounds maintenance, utilities including heating, ventilation and air conditioning/refrigeration, electrical and plumbing, housekeeping, environmental, health and safety, and administrative services.
