- SBA may award a direct award contract (commonly referred to as a sole source) with an unlimited ceiling to an 8(a) participant owned and controlled by an ANC [13 CFR 124.506(b)]
- Quick, smooth transition to full contract operations typically in 30 to 60 days
- Awards above \$25M for federal civilian agencies require a J&A [FAR 6.302-5(b)(4)]
- For the DoD, awards above \$100M require a J&A [Class Deviation 2020 – O0009]
- Limited potential for award protest [13 CFR 124.517(a)]
- Small Disadvantaged Business and Native American Credits [13 CFR 124.109(a)(4)]
- Negotiated fair price

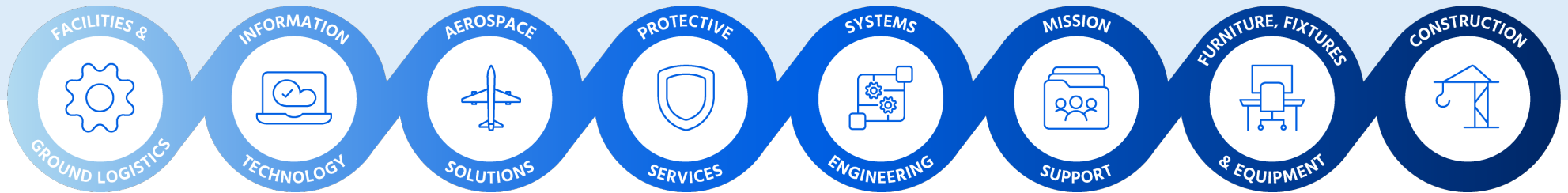
## 8(a) Direct Award Process

- 1 Contracting Officer determines company is capable
- 2 Contracting Officer makes a request to the SBA to determine if the company is able to receive a direct award
- 3 SBA response within 5 days
- 4 Contracting Officer releases RFP performance requirements to direct award recipient
- 5 Recipient responds and negotiations are completed
- 6 Contracting Officer makes the award
